
Voluntary Campaign Contribution Limitations

The Ogden Ethics Project encourages elected officials to represent all of Ogden's citizens, rather than a small number of special interests. To further this goal, we ask you, as a candidate, to consider the following voluntary limitations on financing your campaign. These limitations are modeled on policies that are already mandated in many states and at the federal level. If you are elected, we hope you will introduce legislation to make these restrictions mandatory in Ogden.

Please check the box for each limitation that you agree to observe for the duration of the 2011 campaign season, *provided that your opponent(s) similarly agree(s)*. After we receive your response, we will notify you immediately if/when we receive a response from your opponent(s). We will also post a summary of all candidates' responses (or lack thereof) on the Ogden Ethics Project web site.

- My campaign will not accept contributions from corporations, business entities, unions, or other organizations, with the exception of Utah Political Action Committees that are in compliance with all registration and disclosure laws.
- My campaign will accept contributions from Utah Political Action Committees only if they are in compliance with all registration and disclosure laws and are not being used to circumvent contribution limits or disclosure requirements.
- My campaign will not knowingly accept contributions that are made indirectly through third parties, for the purpose of circumventing contribution limits or disclosure requirements, or for any other purpose. My campaign will not encourage anyone to make a contribution through a third party.
- My campaign will not encourage anyone to make independent expenditures, bypassing my campaign treasury, on my behalf or in opposition to any of my opponents. My campaign will not work in coordination with anyone making such independent expenditures.
- My campaign will require any individual who contributes \$250 or more to report the name of his or her employer, and my campaign will include this information on disclosure forms filed with the city.
